- Therapeutic Intervention: Provide direct therapy using a variety of techniques, including play-based and sensory-motor approaches, to promote participation and engagement.
- Documentation: Maintain timely, accurate, and thorough documentation of evaluations, treatment sessions, progress notes, and discharge summaries.
- Family Education & Coaching: Collaborate with families to share strategies, reinforce skills at home, and support carryover of therapy goals.
